Use the Homemaking Department Entry Form for all Sections.

- **ONLY** Clarke County residents are eligible to enter exhibits, unless otherwise indicated.
- Entry close date for all Areas is July 31, 2026.
- No exhibit that has been shown in previous years can be accepted.
- Exhibitors are limited to one (1) exhibit per class.
- Where there is no competition in an area, the judges reserve the right to award the prize the item is worthy of, or if it is not worthy no prize will be given.

Step 1: Complete and turn in your Entry Form by July 31, 2026:

 - **Do not bring your actual entry item at the time you drop off the entry form.**

Step 2: Pick up your Exhibit Tags:

- **Exhibit Tags** may be picked up at the fair office July 28th – 30th, 4pm – 8pm. Tags will not be available after that date. Every effort will be made to accommodate all entrants.

Step 3: Bring Exhibit Entries in for placement:

- **Exhibit Entry Dates:** Saturday, August 8th, 4pm – 8pm and Sunday, August 9th, 4pm – 8pm.
 - **No exhibits are accepted after August 9th.** No exceptions.
- Exhibits must be picked up **Sunday, August 16 from 12:30 pm - 3:30 pm.**

Cakes, Candy, Cookies, Pies & Bread (Area I)

1. Exhibitors are limited to one (1) exhibit per class.
2. No prepared mixes can be used for any entry.
3. Miscellaneous entries must have name and description on entry tag.
4. "NOTE: All food exhibits must be displayed in a clear container to be provided by the Homemaking Department unless otherwise indicated.
5. Exhibit tags are to be attached to the top of container using tape.
6. These containers will be available for pick-up in the fair office when your tags are picked-up. We ask that you limit the number of containers to only what you need for display.

2. Exhibitor must bring the opened bag of King Arthur Flour or submit a UPC label from the flour bag when he/she submits the entry.
3. Contestant must follow the designated recipe for Cake, Applesauce Cake (your personal recipe)
4. Each contestant must provide a legible recipe, with the entry. Prefer a typed recipe.
5. Must include Name, Address, and phone number.
6. All entries must be submitted in the disposable container.
7. Entries will be judged on taste, overall appearance/creativity, and texture.

Food Preservation (Area 2)

1. Exhibitors are limited to one (1) exhibit per class.
2. All items – Use clear, standard jars or standard jelly jars and leave rings on jars.
3. All jars MUST BE CLEAN AND NOT STICKY and filled to the first rim.
4. NO RUST ON LID OR RINGS. PRODUCT SHOULD NOT BE ABOVE THE RING.
5. All jars must have a vacuum seal; without paraffin; Excluding Sections D, J, and K.
6. Home processed, not bought and reprocessed.
7. NO “freezer” jam.
8. Miscellaneous entries must be named on the entry tag.
